What is GPSC?



The Gujarat Public Service Commission (GPSC) was formed under article 315(1) of the Constitution of India in 1st May 1960. To select applicants for civil service in the Indian state of Gujarat according to the merits of the applicants and the rules of reservation. It was formed in 1960.

As per Article No. 316 of Constitution of India, State Governor has the power to select members and chairman of their respective state's P.S.C.

Presently, Nalin Upadhyay is the Chairman of GPSC.






