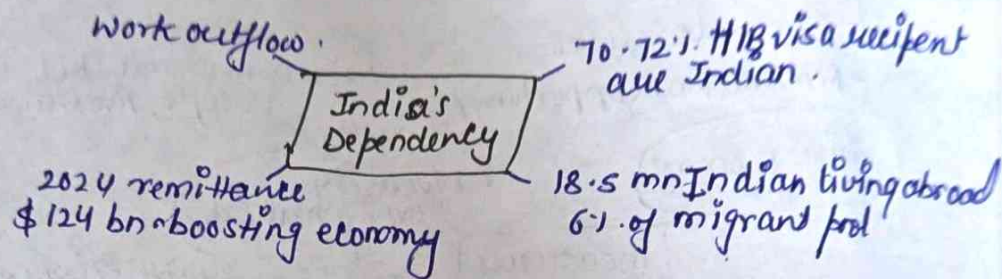

Good - Covers IT sector impact, remittances, brain drain, unemployment and India-US relations. Use of diagrams/flowcharts adds clarity.

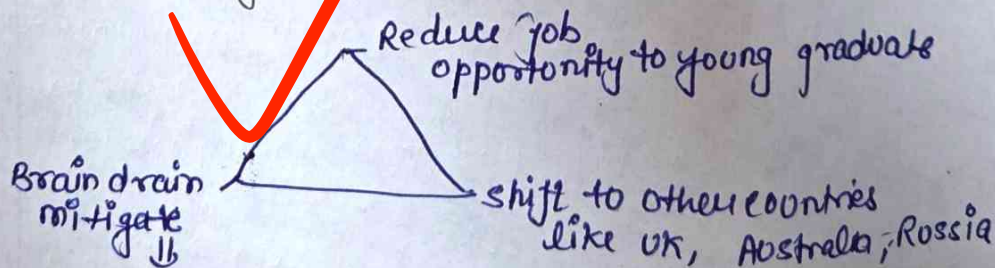

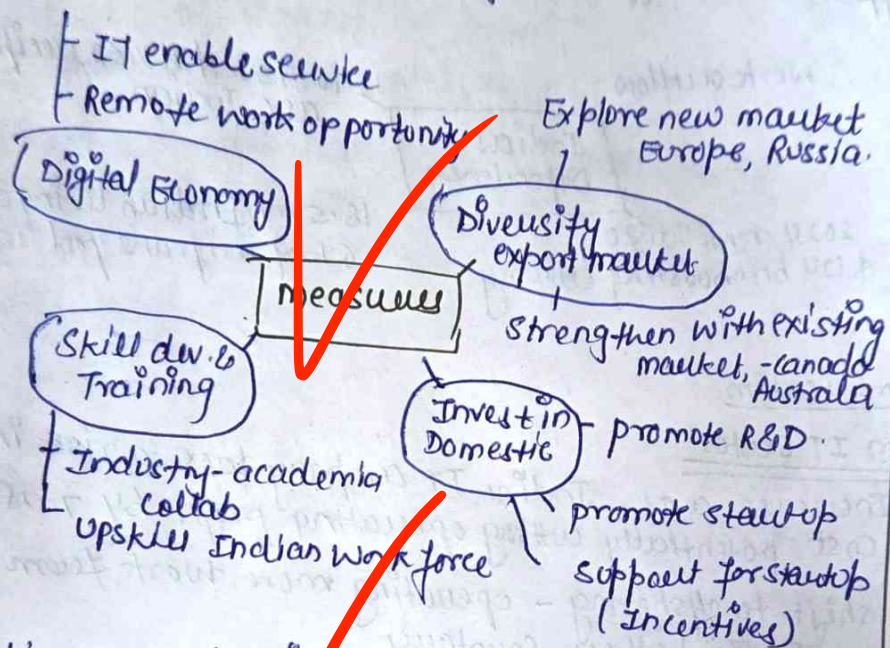


## India-US Relation
