Conclusion / Measures:

Good – Divides measures into Infrastructure, Economy, and Social. References to R&D and PM Kaushal Vikas Yojana are apt. Conclusion frames the issue as a wake-up call to strengthen India's domestic market.

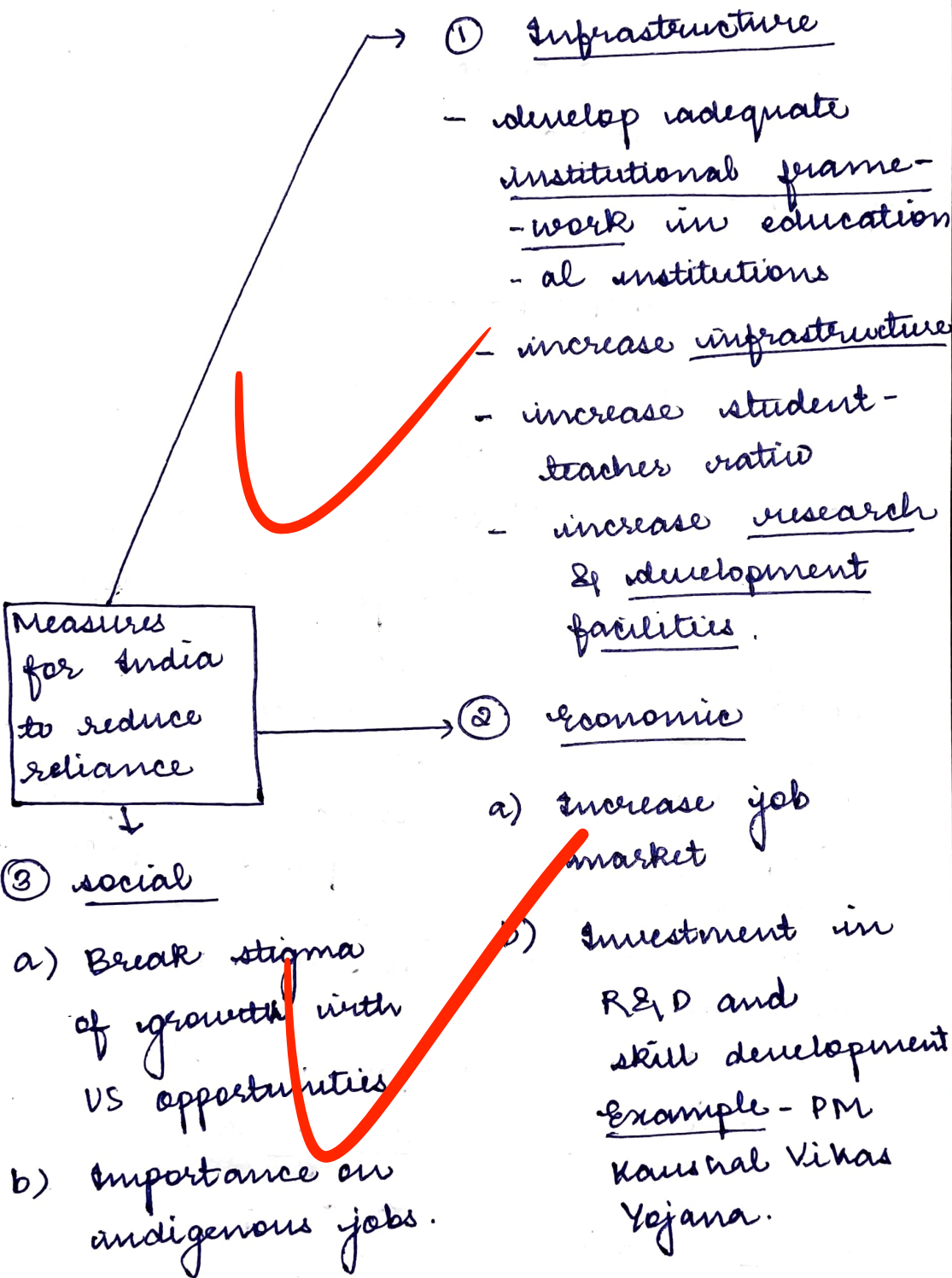
Improve – Could end with one impactful line on "turning external shocks into an opportunity for Atmanirbhar Bharat."
